The Premium Book (list of departments and classes) for 2024 has not been published yet. It will be similar to last year, which is still available on the Grange Fair website above.

Needlecraft is Department 18. Here you can enter all your weaving, spinning, knitting, crochet, sewing, quilting, embroidery, etc. You can enter as many items as you want, but only one per class (Department 18 Needlecraft, Division 1890, Class 139 – Christmas Article Useful, Knit).

The process to enter can be a little confusing. Determine what items you want to enter and what classes the items fit. Complete the entry form by the due date. <u>https://middletowngrangefair.org/exhibits</u> Please note: as of 4/24/24, this page has not been updated yet for 2024.

Saturday and Sunday are days to go the fairgrounds and pick up your entry tags. Be sure your tags are scanned in so your items get on the judges list. Take your tags home and attach them to your items. Drop off is on Monday. You can also pick up your tags on Monday, attach them to your items and drop off. Entry fees are paid when tags are picked up. Tags are picked up in the Grange Fair office building and items are dropped off in the barn where the items are exhibited.

All items have to be picked up by the end of the fair on Sunday. Premium checks (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place) are available at the end of the fair. They prefer that you not cash your check and consider it a donation to the fair.

So warp your loom, oil your wheel, or grab your knitting needles and get a little friendly competition going!
